

PUBLIC NOTICE PRESS RELEASE – 01/2020 210 TENANTS SAFETY & SECURITY - PRIORITY FOR THE BOARD

Public Rental Board, in an effort to ensure that all its estates are secured and safe is installing CCTV Cameras as a pilot project in Raiwai before they are implemented in all other PRB rental estates around the country.

The Board last month awarded the contract to Shazcom Technology for the installation of 29 CCTV cameras at its Raiwai Rental Estate. These cameras have now been installed.



Installation of CCTV Cameras at the Raiwai Rental Estate was completed by Friday (3 July 2020) and ready to go live next week. Work on CCTV Cameras at the Mead Road Estate will commence from next week for a duration of three weeks which will be followed by the Nadera Estate. This will provide a sense of security to 310 more tenants. Installation of CCTV Cameras at the three estates is expected to be completed by the end of August

Public Rental Board, noting the increase in crime rate and unwanted guests at the estates, believes that with the installation of CCTV Cameras will:



- i. Deter Crime in PRB estates:
- ii. Closely monitor tenants and visitor activities within the estate;
- iii. Provide a safe and secure community for tenants to live in; and
- iv. Identify and take necessary action on those who litter.

Discussions have already been held with the Fiji Police Force on providing links to access the CCTV feed from their command center to monitor the activities in PRB estates.
