Eligibility Criteria

- First-time home owner;
- Fiji Citizenship;
- Annual Household income must be \$50,000.00 or below;
- Ability to meet the financing of the house; and
- Applicant should be above 18 years of age.

Before you start your online application, please ensure scanned copies of the following documents are ready:

- HA Standard Statutory Declaration (available on our HA website);
- Voter ID or copy of Passport bio-data page;
- Latest Payslip stamped by the employer;
- If owning any business or are self-employed, please attach a Notice of Assessment for the year 2024;
- Latest extract of Birth Certificate and Marriage Certificate;
- TIN letter or FRCS/FNPF joint card; and
- Latest FNPF Statement.

Note:

- For single applicant(s) Applicants need to provide a single status certificate from the Ministry of Justice.
- For married applicant(s) Both spouses need to provide their details as per the above checklist. Should a spouse be unemployed, a proper declaration is required in the statutory declaration form but he/she will need to provide other relevant documents as per the checklist.
- **De-facto relationship** statutory declaration to be attached stating years of relationship and attach partner's details, and to provide other relevant documents as per the checklist.
- **If Divorced** dissolution of marriage to be attached.
- **If widow/widower** death certificate to be attached.

*The above information is required to determine Total Household Income and Loan eligibility.
