



Housing Authority – EOI Covata (Round 3) Vacant Lots

Public Notice: Objection Process for 8 Additional Qualified Applicants

The Housing Authority hereby advises the public that **eight (8) additional applicants have qualified** to proceed to the barrel draw for the sale of vacant residential lots at **Covata, Labasa – Round 3**.

The applicants were shortlisted in accordance with the Housing Authority's **Lot Allocation Policy** and the established eligibility criteria, which require applicants to:

- Be a **first-time homeowner**;
- Be a **Fijian citizen**;
- Have a **combined annual household income below \$50,024.00**; and
- Be **18 years of age or older**.

BACKGROUND

A total of **56 applicants** initially qualified and advertised for the public **Objection Process on 13 June 2026**. A further reassessment based on the Government's Housing Assistance Grant (HAG) was carried out and the Housing Authority identified eight (8) additional applicants who met the eligibility requirements for consideration in the Covata Round 3 Barrel Draw.

Accordingly, the Housing Authority is now publishing the names of these eight (8) additional applicants for the purpose of the public Objection Process.

OBJECTION PROCESS

Members of the public are invited to submit objections against any of the **eight (8) qualified applicants** where there is reasonable belief that an applicant does not meet the stated eligibility criteria. All objections must be based on reasonable grounds and should be supported by **relevant evidence or information**, where available.

Members of the public are reminded that the publication of an applicant's name on the provisional list **does not guarantee final allocation of a lot**. All applicants will be subject to the **Objection Process and final verification of eligibility** before they are considered for the final **Barrel Draw**.

The Housing Authority encourages members of the public to participate responsibly in the Objection Process and to provide only genuine and relevant information relating to the eligibility of the provisionally selected applicants.

Please submit your objection letter, along with all relevant supporting evidence, via email to **Objection-Covata@housing.com.fj** no later than **4:30 pm on Monday, 07 September 2026**.

Kindly ensure that the **email subject line clearly states the Principal Applicant's number and full name** to facilitate proper identification and processing.

What Happens Next?

Applicants for whom no objections are received by the stated deadline will advance to the final selection stage. This stage will involve a **transparent barrel draw** to allocate **one of the 43 available lots at Covata (Phase 3)**.
